

Second call for papers - XXII Annual Inflation Targeting Conference - Banco Central do Brasil

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Banco Central do Brasil is organizing its XXII Annual Inflation Targeting Conference, which will be held in Rio de Janeiro on May 20-22, 2020.

The Conference brings together researchers from academia, central banks and multilateral institutions as well as private sector specialists. The Conference considers papers relating to all areas of monetary economics, such as monetary policy, inflation targeting, central bank communication, forecasting, modelling, and related areas, such as fiscal policy, labor economics, and international economics.

The 2020 program will include presentations and discussions of selected articles from this Call, as well as invited lecturers. The Conference will have academic sessions on the first two days and policy-oriented sessions on the third day, when the event is open for the press, with the presence of the Governor and Deputy Governors of the Banco Central do Brasil and private sector specialists.

We have confirmed the presence of **Enrique Mendoza** (UPenn) and **Alan Taylor** (UC Davis) as our keynote speakers.

The Banco Central do Brasil will cover travelling (economy class) and hotel expenses (up to three nights in a hotel chosen by the organizers), as well as transportation costs to and from the event for one author per paper selected for the conference.
