**Emi Nakamura** is the Chancellor's Professor of Economics at University of California, Berkeley, a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, a co-director of the Monetary Economics Program of the NBER and a co-editor of the American Economic Review. She was awarded the John Bates Clark Medal in 2019, the Elaine Bennett Research Prize in 2014 and was named one of "the decade's eight best young economists" in 2018 by The Economist.

**Jordi Galí** is Director and Senior Researcher at the Center for Research in International Economics (CREI), Professor at Universitat Pompeu Fabra and Research Professor at the Barcelona GSE. He has served as a co-editor of the Journal of the European Economic Association. In 2012 he served as President of the European Economic Association. He is a regular consultant to the ECB, the Sveriges Riksbank and the Norges Bank.
