### FEDERAL RESERVE DAY-AHEAD CONFERENCE ON FINANCIAL MARKETS AND INSTITUTIONS

The 15th annual Day-Ahead Conference on Financial Markets and Institutions is an opportunity for productive interaction in advance of the 2022 ASSA meeting and the sharing of policy-relevant research among economists in the Federal Reserve System, at other central banks, and in academia. **As with many conferences, covid-19 introduces substantial uncertainty into planning. We will decide at the earliest possible time about whether to hold the conference in person or as a virtual event. At this point, we cannot guarantee that we will hold an in-person conference even if the ASSA does so.**

The Day-Ahead organizing committee invites the submission of both theoretical and empirical research on domestic and international financial markets and institutions, particularly involving topics relevant to central bank mandates such as:

- Bank and nonbank financial intermediation
- Financial markets and the macroeconomy
- Unconventional monetary policy tools and their effects
- Household finance and the transmission of monetary policy
- Emerging risks such as climate change and cyber risk
- Financial stability and the conduct of monetary policy
- The impact of macroprudential policies
- The functioning of money markets
- Interconnection of global financial markets
- The effects of uncertainty on financial markets and institutions
- Supervision and regulation of financial institutions

Completed drafts will be given a higher preference than abstracts. Among papers of similar quality, a paper with a coauthor from a central bank will be given preference.
